HR Department Highlights

Referral Bonus Reminder
We are looking for great staff members like you!

Who is eligible: All full time and part time employees

What are the current bonus levels? \$1,000 for any open position \$2,000 for a Radiologic Tech, a Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT), Registered Nurse (RN) \$5,000 for a physician or advanced practitioner

What do you need to do to participate?

- Find someone you respect and would like to work with and ask them if they would be interested in working at NMMC
- Fill out this form and provide it to HR
- Ask the person you are referring to apply through our applicant portal on the NMMC website Careers tab

It's that easy!

- If the applicant meets the qualifications for the position and they are interviewed and
- If NMMC extends an offer of full time (32 or more hours per week) and it is accepted by your referral, then you receive a bonus (bonus pro-rated for acceptance of a part time position)

When do you receive your bonus?

- When the applicant you referred completes 90 days of employment you receive the first half of the applicable Referral Bonus
- When the applicant you referred completes six months of employment you receive the second half of the applicable bonus
